

Adventures in Science

Students complete 17 modules as they move from Kindergarten to 5th grade. They develop ideas and inquiry skills as they study one topic and a small number of key concepts as they work through investigations over a 6-8 week period. As they work through the modules, they cover topics and areas that engage and interest them. Students will work in cooperative learning teams to explore the world around them and solve problems that are interesting to them.

Topics include The Senses, Living Things, The Weather, Balls & Ramps, Liquids & Sounds, Bones & Skeletons, The Earth, The Sun & The Moon and Circuits & Pathways.
